

## Incentives for Jobseekers

### **A Personal Adviser**

A friendly and helpful adviser, who will give you all the support you need to get started in a job that is right for you. Even in work we can provide In Work Advisory Support. We can also help with Job search activities, preparing CV's etc through partner organisations.

### **Working Tax Credit**

Payment to top up the earnings of working people.

### **Job Grant**

A one off payment of £100 or £250 when you start work conditions apply

### **In Work Credit**

Weekly payment of £60 paid up to 52 weeks for parent families when you start work of over 16 hours per week. Conditions apply.

### **Extended Housing Benefit Council Tax Benefit Run on**

Housing Benefit, Mortgage Payment, and Council Tax Benefit paid for 4 weeks after you start work.

### **Work Trial**

You can try a job for up to 15 days without the risk of losing benefits. You will receive lunch allowance and your fares.

### **Other Financial Help**

Fund to remove barriers to employment. See Adviser for details.

### **Better off in work calculations**

This is a calculation of how much better off you can be in work

### **Child Tax Credit**

Payment to support families with children

### **Childcare**

Need help with finding the right childcare? Speak to an Adviser

### **Childcare Assist**

We can help with the costs of formal childcare place for up to 5 days before you start work. Conditions apply.

**Childcare Costs**

We can pay generous childcare costs, if you are using a registered childcare provider, conditions apply.

**Reduced Travel Cost**

**Training Premium**

We can pay an additional £15 per week on top of existing benefits, when a customer participates in approved training, agreed with their adviser.

**Flexible Training**
